Letters and Sounds In Nursery, we use a document called 'Letters and Sounds' to plan daily activities. This half term, we are working on segmenting words e.g. dog becomes d-o-g and hearing initial sounds in words e.g. snake begins with ssssss, mouse begins with mmmmmmm.
