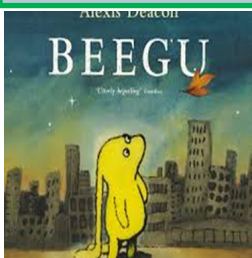
It has been another busy week at Roskear!

Finally I'd like to thank you for your continued support and trust.

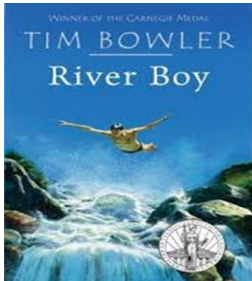
