Summer Holiday Lunches

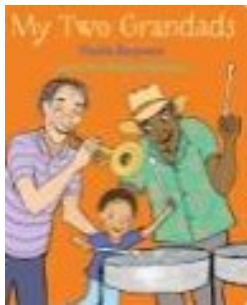

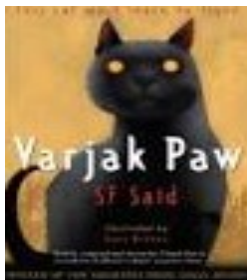


KS1 Book Of The Week: My Two Granddads

Author: S F Said


Book Level: 3.8
