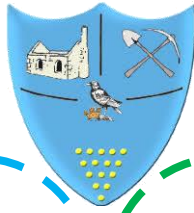


Reception Newsletter

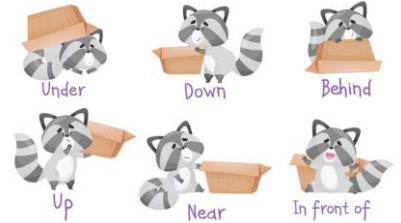
We are looking forward to the next half term, thank you for your continued support. We will do all that we can to support you and your children and are always available to answer any questions or assist with any needs you may have.
