Titanic Timeline (Edwardian Period)

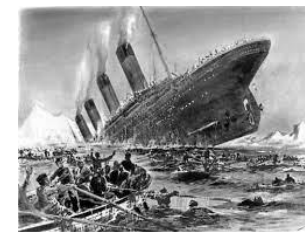
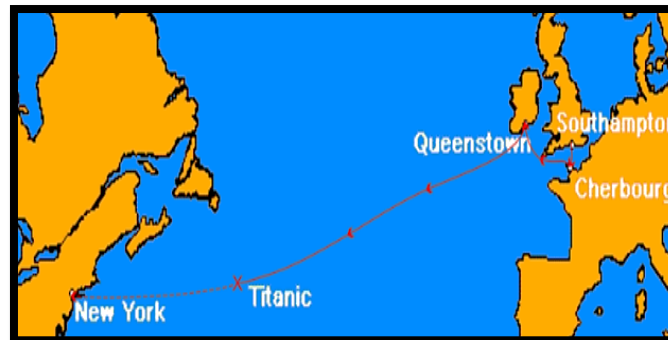
