

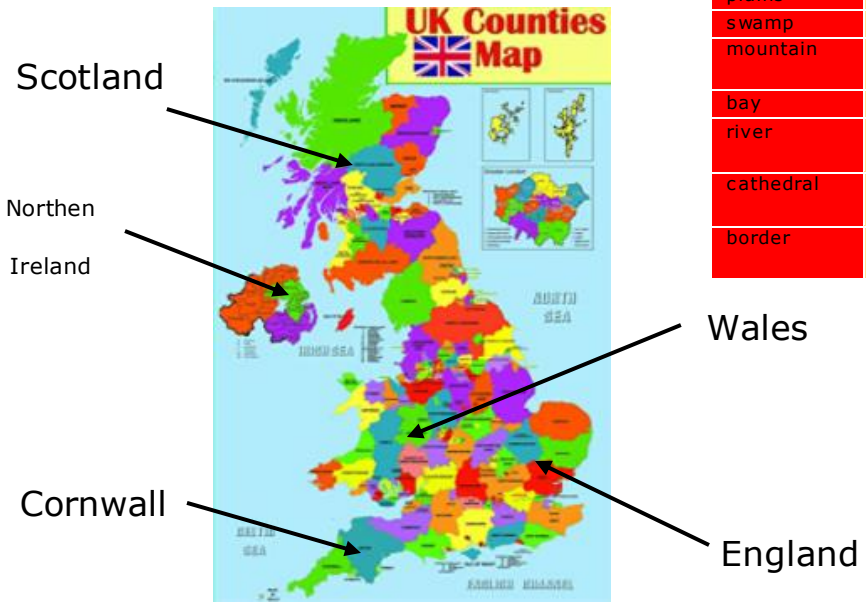


# Year 2- Spring 1- An Island Home

bay	a body of water partly surrounded by land

cathedral	a Christian church that is the home church of the bishop and is larger and more decorative
border	the line between two countries, counties or towns
