



# The Equality Act, 2010 (England)

**It is against the law to discriminate against anyone because of**

- age
- gender reassignment
- being married or in a civil partnership
- being pregnant or on maternity leave
- *disability*
- race, including colour, nationality, ethnic or national origin
- religion or belief
- sex
- sexual orientation

**These are called 'protected characteristics'**
