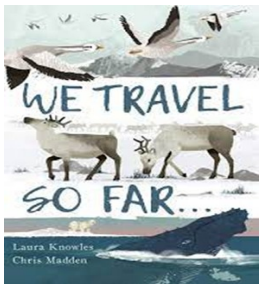

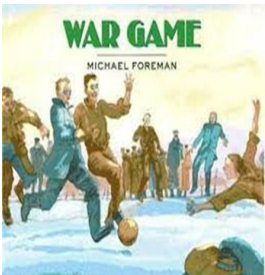

## Team 5 & 6

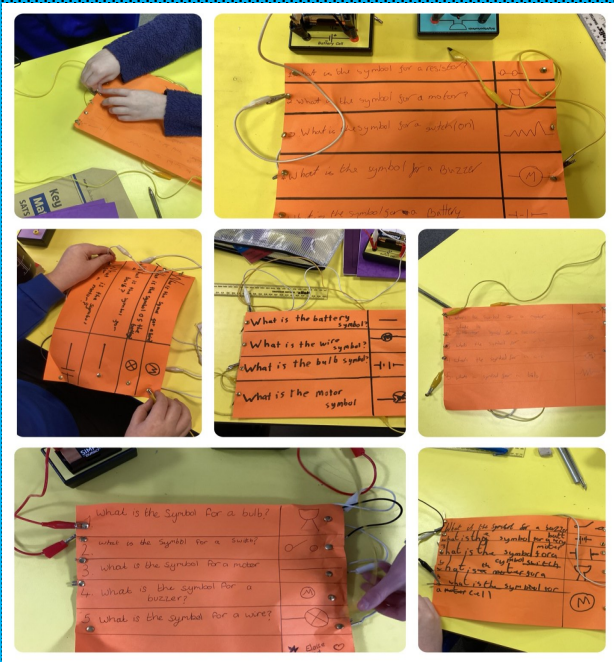
This week, Year 6 have been carrying out science experiments while testing each other's knowledge.

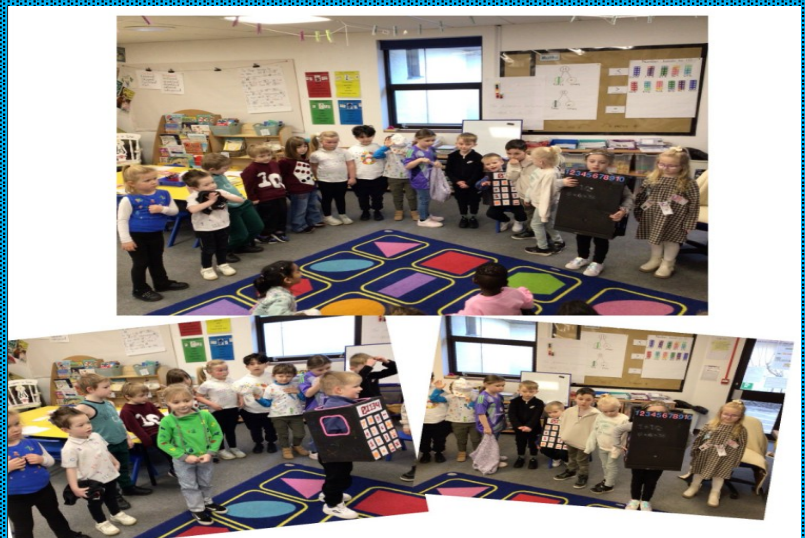
