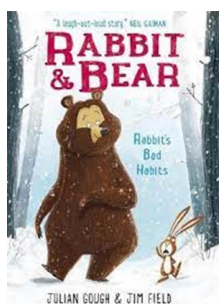

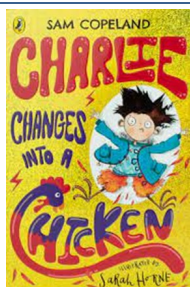


KS1 Book Of The Week: **Rabbit & Bear**

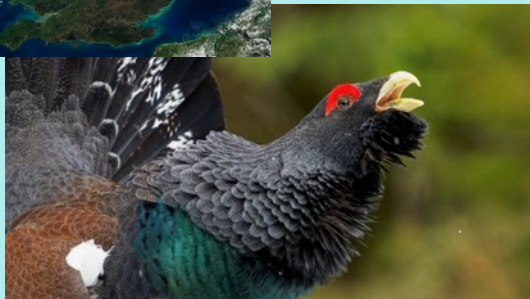

This week, year 3 have kick started their geography unit - all about woodland and forest by studying the David Attenborough documentary - Wild Isles.

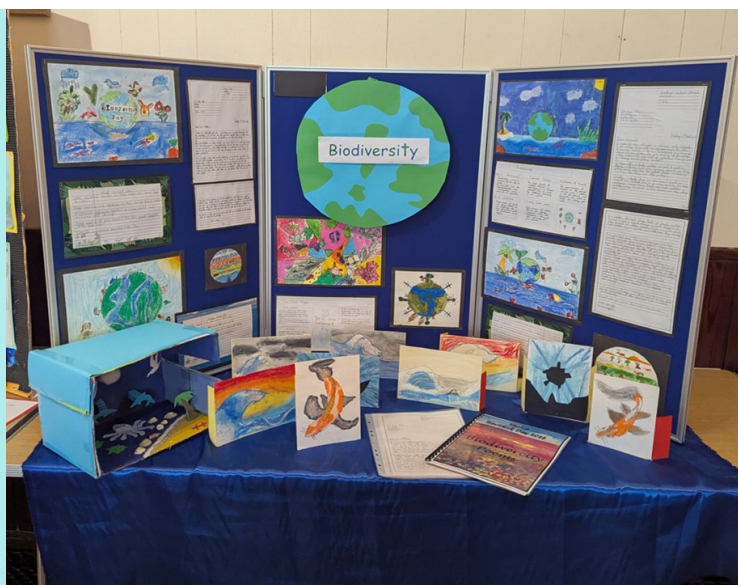
We learnt all about the different forests in the UK and what is affecting them the most.
