Dear Parent/Carer,

It is very rare for me to write to you with concerns but today I am. I am concerned for the number of our children that are on social media and online; potentially putting themselves at risk of harm or behaving in an inappropriate and unkind way. This week, I have seen videos of children videoing themselves on Tik Tok, on a school day, at 11.40pm when they should be fast asleep in bed. Such incidents like this are a significant safeguarding concern for the school and may result in the school contacting social care due to parents not proactively keeping their child(ren) safe. Please can I ask you to consider how long, what time of day and what your child is doing when they are on there. We recommend that children should not have their phones in their room and most certainly not at bedtime. Most social media platforms have a minimum age limit and that is there for a reason – it is there to keep children safe. Inappropriate/unkind/offensive behaviour that impacts back in school will be dealt with in accordance with our behaviour policy. Please remember that offensive behaviour should always be reported to the police.

We enjoyed singing our Christmas songs as well as sharing festive stories together.


We hope that you continue to sing these over the Christmas period, spreading some Christmas cheer! Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year!



