Each week we will hear from a different class about their learning for the week.

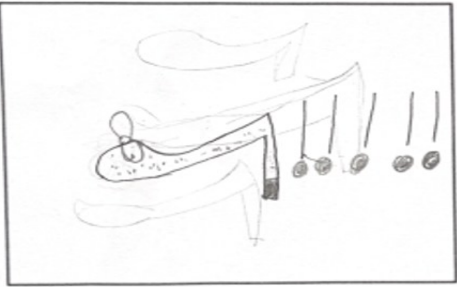
WELCOME BACK!

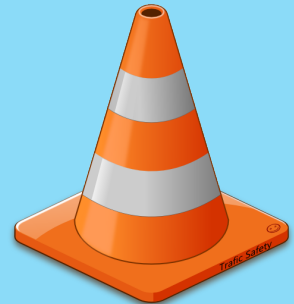
